

## 22. German International Amateur Championship

Boys and Girls

4 – 6 June 2026 at Golf Club Bad Saarow

\* Qualifying Tournament for PING Junior Solheim Cup



### Announcement

#### 1 | Eligibility

Amateurs (boys and girls) born in 2008 or later, who are members of a German golf club associated with the German Golf Association (DGV) or a foreign golf club associated with its respective national golf association.

Players who have registered as eligible to participate via handicap-index must send an official certificate of their respective handicap eligibility not later than 19 May 2026, 12:00 via mail to [wso@dgv.golf.de](mailto:wso@dgv.golf.de). Otherwise, players are not eligible to participate in this championship.

#### 2 | Maximum entries / Limit of handicap-index / Exemption clause / Waiting list / Withdrawals

108 girls and 108 boys are eligible to play. The players listed under No. 15 are automatically eligible without consideration of their handicap-index.

The organisers reserve the right to increase or reduce the number of participants before the tournament (or the registration deadline) and to adjust the entry criteria in the announcement.

Players with a maximum handicap-index of 0,0 for boys and girls will be entered according to their handicap-index.

When the starting field is complete, the remaining entries will be placed on a waiting list according to their handicap-index. In case of subsequent withdrawals, players on the waiting list will be invited to compete **by 2 June 2026, 12:00**.

##### Withdrawals:

If, for any reason, a competitor is unable to participate, he or she has to communicate this to the German Golf Association **before 19 May 2026**. Otherwise the entrance fee will not be refunded.

## **Ties (Regulation for equal results)**

In the event of a tie for first place, the winner will be decided by a hole-by-hole play-off. If a play-off involves more than two players, those other than the winner will be deemed to have tied for second place regardless of their scores in the play-off.

The winning girl will be honoured as "German International Girls Champion, 2026"

The winning boy will be honoured as "German International Boys Champion, 2026"

## **Livescoring (Rule 3.3 b (2)):**

A mobile scoring application will be used in addition to a paper scorecard. To help in administrative matters, players are required to enter scores for each hole using their own cell phones. A mobile scoring website will be provided.

If there is any discrepancy, the paper scorecard will be decisive.

Players can be penalised by the Committee with regard to the Code of Conduct (see Local Rule / Rule 1.2b) if they refuse to enter scores into the mobile scoring website. There may be penalties regarding future participation.

## **Nations Cup:**

Separate gross competition for boys' and girls' teams.

54 holes stroke-play team event:

Thursday 1st round, 18 holes

Friday 2nd round, 18 holes

Saturday 3rd round, 18 holes

Teams of two or three players, who entered the competition before the closing date and have been named by their national association, either in advance to the office of the German Golf Association or on the practice days by 16:00 in the tournament office, are eligible to play in the Nations Cup.

Each country may enter up to two boys' teams and two girls' teams.

The two best scores of each team for the first, second and third round count. In the event of a tie, the best team score of round three counts, thereafter the best individual score of round three, thereafter the non-counting score of player three of round three, thereafter the decision is made by chance (such as tossing a coin).

The tees to be played will be announced before the practice round.

Appointed by the German Golf Association.

## 7| Closing date / Entrance fee / Entry form

### Closing date for the Championship:

19 May 2026, 12:00

### Entrance fee:

€ 150,- to be paid by 26 May 2026. Members of a German golf club associated with the DGV pay their entrance fee via SEPA direct debit. Foreign players pay via a SumUp link that will be sent by email after the registration deadline (otherwise, players are not eligible to compete).

### Entrance fee includes:

- One practice round and three tournament rounds
- One dinner
- Fruit and drinks on the golf course
- Unlimited practice balls on the driving range

In case of a successful registration, the player receives a confirmation via E-Mail.

The list of accepted players and the waiting list will be published online after the closing date.

## 8| Conditions of competition

The Championship is played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A and the Local Rules for the competition.

The World Handicap System and the general conditions of competition of the German Golf Association apply for the tournament.

In case of doubt, the German version of all conditions is decisive.

The Committee reserves the right to alter the conditions.
